



DISPLAY SPACES AVAILABLE FOR THE 2026 SUNSHINE COAST ART CRAWL

The District of Sechelt's community public art program showcases the work of local artists and highlights the creativity of our community. The District of Sechelt is inviting artists to apply for the opportunity to display their work in the Rockwood Lodge and Mission Point House during the 2026 Sunshine Coast Art Crawl (October 23, 24, 25, 2026). All three venues are wheelchair accessible and contain a kitchen and accessible bathroom.

ELIGIBILITY

Artists must:

1. Be a local resident who has a Sunshine Coast address
2. Be in need of a publicly accessible studio space for the Art Crawl (i.e. your artwork is not already on display at another location during the Art Crawl).
3. Apply to the Sunshine Coast Art Crawl as a solo-artist or as a group of artists and follow the participation guidelines as described by the Coast Cultural Alliance at www.sunshinecoastartcrawl.com
4. Have at least 1 artist in attendance at the venue for the duration of the Art Crawl (10am – 5pm Friday, Saturday & Sunday)
5. Pay a \$300 refundable damage deposit and obtain \$2 million liability coverage for the duration of the event

To apply, submit the following by **Monday, May 4th at 9am** to events@sechelt.ca

1. Cover letter including name and contact information
2. Artist CV or résumé
3. A written statement (250-350 words) describing your artistic practice and your interest in this opportunity. Please indicate whether you want either the Rockwood Lodge (main or lower floor) or the Mission Point House.
4. Samples of artwork (5 to 10 images) that would be on display during the Art Crawl. Please include a list of artworks to accompany the images.

Rockwood Lodge | Art Space

5511 Shorncliffe Avenue

This lower-level space can accommodate 1-2 artists working in 2D (painting, drawing, printmaking etc.). The Arts Space is a 750 sq. ft. room located on the lower level of the Rockwood Lodge heritage building. Walls have art rails for hanging 2D artwork. Tables and chairs are available upon request.



Rockwood Lodge | Main Floor

5511 Shorncliffe Avenue

The main floor space can accommodate 2-4 artists. The main floor of the Rockwood Lodge still captures the original look and feel of the 1920s lodge with tables that can be used for displaying 3D artwork or crafts. Walls in both rooms and main hallway have art rails for hanging 2D artwork.



Mission Point House

4603 Sunshine Coast Highway

This building can accommodate 1 artist working in 2D or 3D. This 900 sq.ft space is post and beam cedar side, with many windows, a living room, dining room, small kitchen, and large deck.
