

How to find the zoning of your property

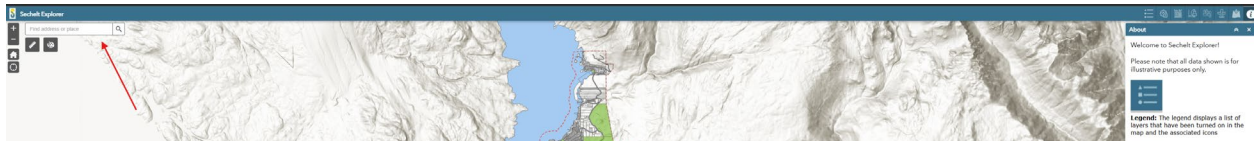
Step 1 – Access the Sechelt Explorer Map

This map can be found on the District of Sechelt website.

- Direct link:

- Manual Navigation:
 1. Go to www.sechelt.ca
 2. Under the “living here” tab, select “maps”
 3. A new page will load; select “Sechelt Explorer” from the top bar (beside the logo)

Step 2 – locate your property

Once loaded, type your address into the search bar in the top left-hand corner

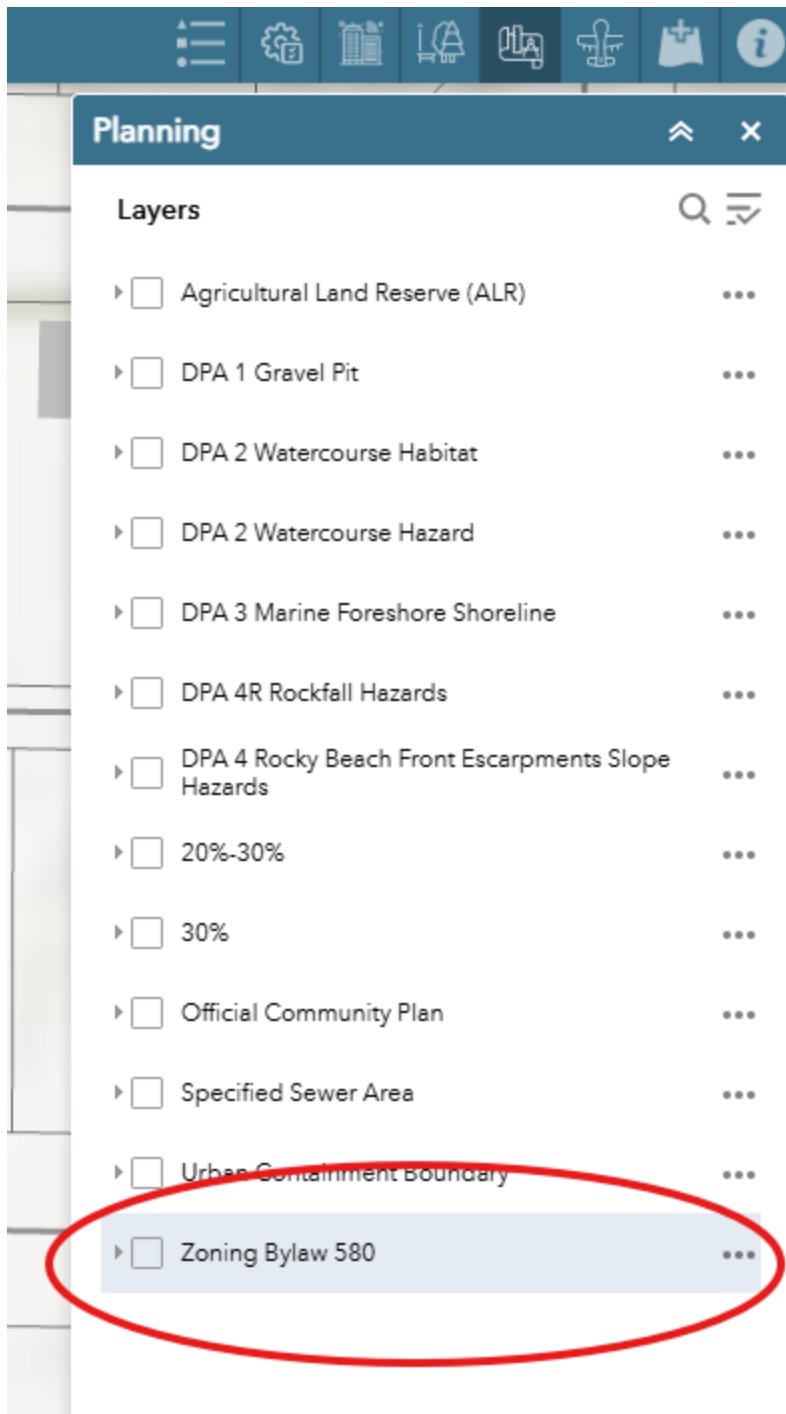


Step 3 – Turn on Zoning Layer

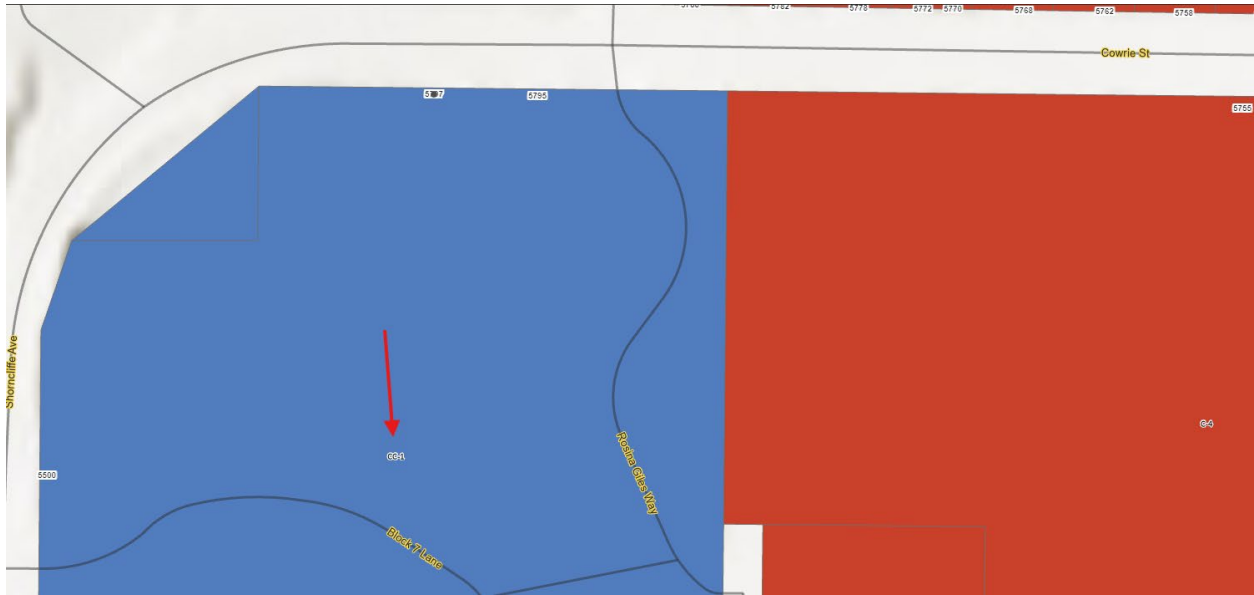
On the top right menu, select the map icon:



From the planning menu, select “Zoning Bylaw 580”:



Once selected, the map should now show colour blocked sections, with the zone identified in white text (examples CC-1, C4 ect..)
